Reporting to the Community Engagement Coordinator and the Senior Medical Office Manager of the HSCHC, the duties include:

- Developing and delivering various community and Health Centre programs including but not limited to: Arts and craft kids fun days, activity programs, special events, parent and tots programs, seniors social and weekly family oriented programming.
- Garden maintenance for community garden at Dr. Arthur Hines School
- General office duties as required

Position Requirements:

- A student 16 years of age or older who is
 - Returning to High School in September 2018, or
 - Accepted to attend at a post-secondary institution in September 2018, or
 - A current post-secondary student that will be returning to a post-secondary institution in September 2018
- Strong verbal and written communication skills.
- Ability to lead a group in an activity.
- Ability to promote events through various media.
- Ability to work independently and plan work activities on a daily and weekly basis
- Ability to multi-task, problem-solve, and respond effectively to the demands of the position
- Strong interpersonal skills and ability to work independently and harmoniously with children, community members, and staff at HSCHC.
- Experience in electronic communication and excellence in Microsoft Office products, including Word.
- Be able to sign a confidentiality agreement.
- Be able to provide a criminal record check and child abuse register before starting employment.
- Must have valid driver's license
